Bargaining gets off to positive start

Update for Local 071, Chapter 010

Negotiations with the employer got off to a good start at the first bargaining meetings on July 29 and 30.

We were able to agree on positive changes to the grievance procedure that should make the process quicker and allow easier access to mediation. We also signed off on improved language about union orientation for new members.

There was agreement on a number of articles that exist in the current agreement and we made minor housekeeping changes to other articles.

The next round of talks is scheduled for Sept. 16 and 17.
